I have a couple of observations from the match that have been passed on to me by other shooters and observed personally as well. The first thing is the Matamoras range is a cold range during an event. At no time should a shooter have a loaded firearm unless under the direct supervision of a range officer. While you may feel that you are confident in your gun handling abilities to carry a loaded firearm, this is a safety issue and a match is no place for a lapse in safety protocol. Second, safe tables areas are not areas to handle magazines or loaded firearms. Any shooter found doing so will be disqualified from the match. Finally, the match took way too long for five stages. We will be looking at adding a fifth squad to help with flow and timing.

The forecast leading up to the match was rather bleak so I have to say that the weather we had for the match could not have been better. I hope everyone had a great time. Our next match will be **May 21st**. This is a third Sunday due to *Memorial Day* and not our typical fourth Sunday.
