## Stage 1 Action Photos



**STAGE 1: POT OF GOLD** Engage T-1 from retention then 3 steel and 1 paper while standing at P-1. Total of 7 rounds.



## Stage 2 Action Photos



**STAGE 2: THE RUN AROUND** On signal engage T-1 thru T-9 with 2 rounds each while using cover throughout the maze of walls. Total of 18 rounds.

**STAGE 3: HARD COVER SEQUENCE** Engage T-1 thru T-4 with 2 rounds each in tactical sequence. Total of 8 rounds.





# Stage 4 Action Photos



**STAGE 4: DYNAMITE REACTION** Engage T-1 thru T-3 at P-1. Move to P-2 and engage steel then pop-up then drop turner and static target. Activate slider and engage with 2 rounds. Total of 15 rounds.







### Stage 5 Action Photos



**STAGE 5: RIGHT AND LEFT** Engage T-1 & T-2 with 2 rounds while retreating to P-2. From P-2 engage T-3 & T-4 with 2 rounds each weak hand only. Total of 8 rounds..



### Stage 6 Action Photos



**STAGE 6: SWING, MOVE, SHO & WHO** From P-1 engage steel and T-1A & T-1, then engage T-3 & T-4 while moving to P-2, then engage T-4 & T-5 strong hand only then again weak hand only. Total of 17 rounds.





**3 GUN STAGE** Engage 4 paper with 2 rounds each from rifle, dump rifle in rack, pick up unloaded shotgun and engage 2 plates on plate rack and 2 poppers with 2 clay birds, dump shotgun in rack. With pistol, engage 2 paper targets with 2 rounds each, then break 4 clay birds. 8 rounds rifle, 6 rounds shotgun, 8 rounds pistol.
