



ACTION *match* PISTOL *news*

This was a match that defines the meaning of; everything does not go according to plan. Instead of clouds and sun we had blistering sun, hot and humid conditions. Instead of easy stages (so I thought in my planning) they turned out to be very challenging.

Instead of stage 6 being used for the BUG match, I adapted stage 3 in order to finish as early as possible. Instead of maybe having 10 BUG shooters we ran 17 competitors through AND we had record attendance (31) at the regular match.

While my scoring program doesn't list procedural and hits on no-threats individually, I tally them up for my information. There were a total of **17 procedural**s as follows: **2** on stage 1, **1** on stage 2, **6** on stage 3, **3** on stage 4 and **5** on stage 6. The total of **no-threat hits were 32** as follows: **5** on stage 1, **16** on stage 3, **6** on stage 4 and **5** on stage 6. These numbers mean to me that the stages were more complex and difficult than I had planned for.

There were 5 new shooters in attendance: **Quadray Posey** (junior), **Luke Dotey** (junior), **Steve Morris**, **Ken Morris** and **Roger McCollum**. The overall winners in the main match are **Peter B**, **Jerry G.** and **Mike L.** Individual stage winners are: **Henry D.** stage 1, **Peter B.** stages 2, 4 and 5, with **Jerry G.** taking stages 3 and 6. Most accurate belongs to **Henry D.** (1 down), **Sal P.** (3), **Dick D.** (6) **Scott Q.** (8) **Bill V.** (9) and **Ralph C.** (9).

There was a tough battle among the junior shooters. **Seth D.** took an early lead and kept it but there was a 3 way battle for second place among **Mckenna Q.**, **Luke D.** and **Quadray P.** After stage 3 **Mckenna** established her lead for 2nd place but **Quadray** and **Luke** battled it out to the end. At the finish, **Quadray** was 3rd by 1.08 seconds.

The BUG match generated a lot of interest. My free scoring program doesn't recognize BUG matches and I also forgot to ask each shooter if they were using semi or revolver. As such, I placed every competitor as SSP unclassified and broke each individual STRING down as a STAGE to suit my program. My apology but this was my 1st BUG match ever and I have learned a lot. Due to the lateness in the day, there was no collection of the \$2.00 or random awards as previously mentioned. Again, nothing seemed to go as planned.

Overall winners of the BUG are **Jerry G.**, **Mike L.** and **Sal P.** Individual STRING winners are: **Jerry G.** for string 1, 2 and 6, **Scott Q.** for string 3 and **James Keveson** for string 4. **Scott Q.** shot the BUG zero down with several others in the single point down category.

This month's 50/50 drawing was won by **Henry D.** for a total of \$43. **Sal P.** gave his tickets away.

Congratulations to all the competitors and thanks to everyone for their cooperation and patience. Remember our **next match is September 16TH** due to the Club steak bake on the 23rd.
