Match Stages

STAGE 1: OPEN SLOT

Engage 6 paper and 2 steel from within the confines of the stage walls. Total of 14 rds.

STAGE 2: BOMB SQUAD

Engage 5 paper targets in 2 arrays, then shoot the "bomb." Total of 11 rds.

STAGE 3: FLOP UPS

Engage 6 paper and 4 steel within the confines of the stage walls. Poppers will present pop up targets. Total of 16 rds.

STAGE 4: FREE TO SHOO

Engage 3 targets with 2 rds. each freestyle, reload, reengage each target with 2 rds. each strong hand only. Total of 12 rds.

STAGE 5: TROUBLE IS SWINGING

Activate the swinger and move to shooting box and engage 4 targets. Total of 8 rds.

STAGE 6: EVERY WHICH WAY

Engage each target array from the respective shooting box, 6 paper and 3 steel for 15 rds. total.

3 GUNNERY: Start in pistol pit 2 with handgun and engage 4 target arrays from 3 shooting areas. Move to Pistol Pit 1 and use shotgun to knockdown 2 steel and 2 clay birds launched by falling steel and 4 stationary clay birds. Move to 200 yard range and engage 2 paper and 1 steel with 3 rds. each. Total 9 rifle, 10 shotgun and 15 pistol rds.
