The last match of our third action pistol shooting season has come to a close. There were 24 shooters in attendance with 1 new (to the club) competitor.

Welcome **Chris Gregorsky**. Winner of the 50/50 raffle was **Susan Bonnett**. We gave **Cathy Dotey** a signed card of appreciation along with a gift card as a token of our thanks for making the lunches something to look forward to after the match.

Overall winner is our junior shooter, **Seth D. Walt J.** (WT) trailed in second place by a mere 2.42 seconds. Not far behind for third was **Sal P.** Top 3 in stage 1 are **WT, John B,** and **Bruce B.** Stage 2 by **Seth D, Sal P,** and **WT.** Stage 3 by **WT, Seth D** and **Sal P.** Stage 4 by **Peter B, Seth D** and **WT.** Stage 5 by **Peter B, Seth D** and **Sal P.** Lastly stage 6 by **Scott Q, Sal P** and **Peter B.**

Zero down honors go to the Quinn clan of **Michael Sr.** and **Scott.** Single digit down honors belong to **Sal P** (3) then **Tim B** (6), **WT**(6) and **Michael Q Jr.** (6).

The side match scores are easily readable but notice that 1st place was won only by 5 hundredths of a second and the difference from 1st to 3rd was only .71 hundredths of a second. I keep saying it; little things can make a difference in results.

If you haven't noticed, these last few matches I have used a couple of stages in which the competitor was given a few options in how to execute the course of fire. I have come to hate the usual IDPA rigid manner in telling the competitor exactly how to shoot the course of fire. The reaction was very interesting to me when I told my squad of shooters some of the options on stage 2 and then when I told them to do a walkthrough, wow, did the place come alive with a sharing of ideas and plans. Next year you should expect to see more of these types of stages. If you are hardcore IDPA, all I can say is; there is an IDPA match at Wilkes Barre in two weeks. (Borrowed from WT).

Main Match Stages



STAGE 1: MONTEZUMA WOES

Seated in outhouse, bad guys approach you. Retrieve gun and engage T-1 thru T-4 with 2 rounds each through the outhouse door. Total of 8 rounds.



STAGE 2: SCOOTER STORE ROBBERY

Push Gwendolyn in her scooter to safety, then engage T-1 thru T-9 with 2 rounds each using cover and tactical priority. Total of 18 rounds.



STAGE 3: PUNT A GOURD

While harvesting pumpkins, robbers try to steal your truck. Engage T-1 thru T-8 with 2 rounds each from cover and in tactical priority. Total of 16 rounds.



STAGE 4: RUBBER GUN SQUAD

You are on desk duty after seeing Zombies on your beat. They invade the station. Engage Zombies 1 thru 4 with 2 to the body and 1 to the head each. Total of 12 rounds.

STAGE 5: FALLING BAD GUY

Defend yourself from gang violence. Engage T-1 thru T-3 with 2 rounds each, then 2 rounds on T-4 while moving to cover. Finish with 2 rounds on T-5 & T-6. Total of 12 rounds.

STAGE 6: SALOON SHOOTIN'

Lawless cowboys take over the saloon. Engage steel target with house gun (2 rounds) then retrieve house shotgun and blast 2 clay birds, finish with your gun with 2 rounds each on T-1 thru T-6 from cover of wagon. Total of 16 rounds.

Side Match Stages

DRILL 1: TRIPLE BILL DRILL

Engage each target (T-1 thru T-3) with 6 rounds each with mandatory reload between each target. Total of 18 rounds.

DRILL 2: FASTest

Draw and engage target with 2 rounds to the head, mandatory reload, re-engage target with 4 rounds to the body. Total of 6 rounds.

STEEL CHALLENGE – FIVE TO GO

Engage steel 1 thru 4 with 1 round each then engage stop plate with 1 round. Total of 5 rounds. Five attempts are made-best 4 will be added for the stage score.
