A total of 28 competitors turned out on this beautiful day to take on another Action Pistol Match. We welcomed 3 new shooters, **Tom Wilbur**, **Cathy Rosanelli**, and new junior; **Will Vealey**. A 50/50

was held with the lucky winner of \$47.00 being **Brendon K.** Many thanks to **Cathy D.** and her helpers for providing a lunch meal for us shooters. All her time is volunteered in case you didn't know.

Overall match winners are **Peter B.**, **Brendon K** and **Sal P.** The race for third was so close that **Sal** beat **Don M.** by only .56 of a second and **Jerry G.** by only .93 of a second. This proves that one or two "down 1" can make a difference in a match. Stage wins go to **Peter B.** for 1,2,3,4 with **Bill V.** taking 5 and **Brendon K.** taking 6. **Bill V.** won stage 5 by only .07 of a second. Little things make a difference. Most accurate is **Bill V.** (4) with **Brent D.** and **Brendon K.** tied for 2nd with (8) followed by **Sal P.** (9).

The youth shooters had another close battle with stage wins passing evenly among the top contenders. **Quadray P.** took the lead with stage 1, **Luke D.** then took stage 2, **Mckenna Q.** won 3, then **Luke** took 4, **Quadray** came and won 5 with **Mckenna** cleaning up 6. When the gun smoke settled, **Mckenna** was the clear winner, **Luke** won second place by only 1.48 sec. over **Quadray** (third). Honorable mention goes to **Will V.** for safely completing his first ever action pistol match.

A dozen competitors stayed and shot the backup gun (BUG) match. For ease in scoring; all shooters are in the SSP division and unclassified class regardless of what you were shooting. **Sal P.** won the match and stages 2 and 3. **Jerry G.** won stage 1. The only zero down shooter was **Sal P.**

**BUG Match Stage:** Stage 3 broken down to 3 strings. 5 rounds from position 1 & 2 of stage 3 while using Tac sequence at P-1, cover and tac. priority at P-2. P-3 is 3 rounds minimum – 1 steel, 1 paper, 1 drop turner. Total 13 rounds.
